

### **Assembling Instructions**

(These pages are not a part of the sheet music.)

For: Strophic On "Away In A Manger" for Pedal Harp Or Lever Harp

#### **Instructions**:

- These instructions are assembling the sheet music by taping. However, a similar
  procedure could be used to put in a three ring notebook or spiral binder instead of
  taping.
- Print the cover title page on heavier, fancy paper.
- Keep a blank sheet of the above paper for the back cover.
- With the cover title page facing up, lay down the cover title page of the music on a flat surface and lay the back cover to the left with a gap between the pages of about the thickness of a sheet of paper.
  - In order to hold these two sheets in place, use a very small piece of clear tape near the top of the gap and another small piece of clear tape near the bottom of the gap.
  - Now, clear tape the gap from top to bottom.
  - Turn the two taped sheets over and clear tape the gap from top to bottom from this side.
  - Turn the sheets over and fold the two sheets along the gap so that the blank sides of each page are facing each other.

# Assembling Instructions (continued): Strophic On "Away In A Manger" for Pedal Harp Or Lever Harp

- With both pages facing up, lay down the first page of the music on a flat surface and lay page 2 to the right with a gap between the pages of about the thickness of a sheet of paper.
  - In order to hold these two sheets in place, use a very small piece of clear tape near the top of the gap and another small piece of clear tape near the bottom of the gap.
  - Now, clear tape the gap from top to bottom.
  - Turn the two taped sheets over and clear tape the gap from top to bottom from this side.
  - Turn the sheets over and fold the two sheets along the gap so that the music on each page is facing each other.
- Insert your folded pages of music into the folded pages of the covers to complete your assembling. From time to time you may have to add tape to the seams if it begins to tear.
