

A 4-FOOT HARP SOLUTION

How do you play a 4-foot harp? On the web I saw one young lady down on her knees playing a 4-foot harp. You could turn an old-timey wash tub upside down for a box to set the harp on if you want that kind of ambience. Or you could use an elegant box for an elegant harp.

I just bought a 4-foot Carmac Ulysse harp from Virginia Harp Center. Artist Joe at wilkinsonswoodworking.com made me an elegant box so that I can play the harp while seated. See pictures harpbox1 and harpbox2. If you can afford several thousand for an elegant harp, then you can afford several hundred for an elegant box to sit it on plus handling and shipping for a wooden box.

Get the footprint for you harp and tell Joe you want a box like he made Daniel Hooke. The box has a lip on the top, leg adjusters on the bottom, handles, violin f holes on the front, and artistic woodworking around the top and bottom – beautiful! You can get a 5- inch level for your harp bag at a hardware store to make the box level. To keep the harp feet from sliding around and squeaking you can get 4 large coasters from sharmusic.com Smart Stop Cello/Bass Endpin Stopper Copper Item# SMRTS COP.
